In order to promote greater awareness among all of its stakeholders, Hostelling Scotland will provide them with reliable and transparent information regarding its energy consumption, its corresponding greenhouse gas emissions and the improvement actions undertaken.

This policy shall apply to all hostels and premises and will be communicated to all our employees in order to keep the awareness and commitment at a high level.

Energy Efficiency

Huge amounts of energy are used by hotel facilities worldwide, most being derived from fossil fuels, thus generating huge amounts of greenhouse gas. By improving the energy efficiency of our hostels and by avoiding waste of energy, we are taking an important step to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and to contribute to the preservation of the earth's natural resource.

As such we:

- Monitor and analyse consumption every day and month through energy impact analysis
- Promote sub metering through the business for further analysis of consumption
- List potential technical improvements annually for capital improvement plans
- Organise preventative maintenance
- Ensure optimal use of plant and machinery
- Use LED energy lamps in all bedrooms, public areas and office spaces
- Use LED for all emergency exit signage
- Promote use of renewable energy where appropriate
- Encourage a "switch off policy" with staff and guests
- Ensure staff are aware of requirement to turn down/off radiator thermostats when rooms are not booked out
- In periods of low occupancy, appropriate sections within the hostels are isolated so heating can be turned off and lighting reduced to emergency levels only
- Purchasing of energy efficient equipment

Water User Minimisation

Hostelling Scotland reduces water use by using products and implementing services and environmental programmes that promote cleaner water as well as more conservative and efficient consumption.

To help with this we ensure where possible the following are implemented:

- Setting objectives for limiting consumption
- Monitoring and analysing consumption every month
- Install water flow regulators on basin and taps
- Install water flow regulators on all showers
- Install energy efficient monitoring for all toilets
- Use efficient laundry equipment
- Recover and use rain water for use within the hotel grounds where possible
- Promote the use of tap water
- Collect and recycle used cooking oils
- Separate and collect grease from foodstuffs

Education and Training

Hostelling Scotland are educating staff and guests on the importance of environmental awareness and thinking greener. From informative newsletters to teambuilding to finding alternative commuting solutions, Green Teams educate and inspire their fellow workers to spread the word about green programmes and what they can do to help.

To promote greener thinking we:

- Educate guests and employees on environmental issues and their impact on our natural resources
- Educate how to protect and improve our environment
- Educate on social programmes that can benefit the community
- Promote green awareness
- Integrate the preservation of the environment in all jobs

Waste Minimisation

Hostelling Scotland aims to reduce the amount of glass, paper and plastic waste we generate, from substituting printed correspondence with e-mail, to the addition of single-stream recycling bins.

Where possible we encourage the hostels, staff and guests to:

- Recycle paper/cardboard packaging
- Recycle glass packaging
- Recycle plastic packaging
- Recycle metal cans
- Organise sorting of waste from guest bedrooms
- Recycle kitchen waste
- Recycle electrical and electronic equipment
- Recycle ink cartridges
- Dispose safely of fluorescent bulbs/tubes
- Promote reuse of unwanted hotel furniture
