Rooms

Capacity 59:

- 1 single
- 22 twins (which can be used as singles)
- 2 triples
- 2 four-bedded

Room configurations may be subject to occasional change.

Catering

Continental breakfast is available between 08.00-10.00.

Self-catering

A large, well equipped self-catering kitchen is available during hostel hours.

There are 2 ovens, 3 hobs and 3 sinks.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery for all guests.

The dining room can seat 48 people.

Facilities

The hostel has a large, comfortable lounge with TV and well-stocked library.

A coin-operated washing machine and tumble dryers are available during opening hours, as is a drying room.

Wi-Fi access is free.

Security

The cycle store can hold around 15 bikes.

There are ample places to securely lock more bikes in the grounds.

Shopping

A small range of snacks and drinks is available at reception.

There are 3 large supermarkets nearby, all with long opening hours.

Local grocers, chemists, newsagents, pubs and restaurants are all within walking distance in the town centre.

The Hatston ferry terminal in Kirkwall is about 3 miles away, which takes about one hour to walk. We

recommend taking the X10 bus, which meets the ferry, to the town centre.

From the town centre you have a 10 minute walk to the hostel. Or a taxi will take you right to our front door.

Please note: if you are using Google Maps for directions make sure you select **Hatston Pier** not Kirkwall Ferry Terminal as they are different locations (if it's telling you it's only 20 minutes' walk, you've picked the wrong one!)

- Skara Brae, a neolithic village
- Ring of Brodgar, impressive stone circle and henge
- St Magnus Cathedral in Kirkwall, a magnificent example of Viking architecture

The islands are a great place to walk, with routes available for all grades of walkers and beautiful scenery. It also offers world class opportunities for diving in historic Scapa Flow.

Nature lovers can potentially spot whales, bottlenose dolphins, seals, otters, short eared owls, hen harriers and many more unusual visitors to these isles.

There's a vibrant arts and crafts community on the islands with opportunities to visit galleries and exhibitions and meet the artists.
