# Welcome to Ullapool Youth Hostel

## Reception

- Open 08.00-10.00 and 16.30-22.30
- Check-in from 16.30
- Checkout by 10.00

The youth hostel is closed from 10.30-16.30. For guests staying another night, the lounge is usually available until midday.

For the comfort and security of all, the front door is locked at midnight – no admission after.

## Rooms

Capacity 44:

- 2 twin-bedded
- 1 triple-bedded (bunk + single)
- 1 four-bedded (2 bunks, ensuite)
- 1 four-bedded (2 bunks)
- 1 five-bedded (2 bunks + single)
- 4 six-bedded (3 bunks)

There are 7 showers and 7 toilets.

Private rooms are available (one en-suite).

Room configurations may be subject to occasional change.

## Catering

The youth hostel offers continental breakfast (served between 08.00-09.00) and packed lunches.

## Self-catering

The kitchen will accommodate 10 people working at the same time.

There are 12 hobs, with 1 domestic oven, 2 fridges (no freezer) and 1 microwave.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's crockery and cutlery to suit meal times for all guests.

The dining room can seat 42 people.

## Facilities

There are 2 lounges seating 12 and 6 people

The laundry facility has 2 coin-operated washing and drying machines.

A drying room available free of charge.

Wi-Fi access is free.

## Security

All rooms have locks.

Please note the front door is locked at midnight and there is no admission after this time.

## Shopping

Ullapool is well served by shops and supermarkets.

The youth hostel has a small range of soft drinks, snacks, souvenirs and maps for sale.

We stock a range of local beers, Scottish lager and cider, plus wine and single malt whisky.

## Directions

**Bus:** to/from Inverness-Ullapool pier, Monday-Sunday, 300 metres.

**Ferry:** Stornoway-Ullapool, Monday-Sunday, 300 metres.

**Car:** off the A835, on Ullapool sea front.

**Train:** Garve 30miles, or Inverness 55 miles.

**On foot:** the hostel is 300 metres from the bus station on Ullapool's seafront.

## Parking

On-street parking only (subject to availability).

There's a large car park approximately 5 minutes' walk from the hostel which is suitable for coaches.

The hostel has cycle storage which can hold up to 15 bikes.
