## Reception

- Checkout 07.00-10.00

The hostel is open to guests all day. Late arrival is by pre-arrangement only.

Dogs are now welcome, for a small fee, when you book a private room. Please let us know in advance to ensure that a dog friendly room is allocated.

## Rooms

Capacity 50:

- 1 one-bedded
- 4 two-bedded (2 dog-friendly)
- 1 three-bedded
- 5 four-bedded (2 dog-friendly)
- 3 six-bedded

There are 14 en-suite rooms, 16 showers and 17 toilets.

Room configurations may be subject to occasional change.

## Catering

We offer continental breakfast, which is normally served from 07.30-09.00 (arrangements can be made for alternative times on request).

We offer packed lunches to individuals and evening meals are available for groups of 20 and over.

All food is freshly prepared on the premises.

Please reserve meals at the time of booking or at least 4 weeks before arrival.

The dining area seats 25 people.

## Self-catering

The kitchen is available to guests from 07.00-10.00 and 16.00-22.00 and has space for 10 people.

There are 4 gas hobs, 2 domestic ovens, 3 fridges and 1 microwave.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery to suit staggered meal times for all guests.

The dining room seats 44 people.

The kitchen is closed for cleaning between 10.00-14.00.

## Facilities

There are 2 small lounges, one with a TV, which can seat up to 12 people.

2 coin-operated washing and drying machines are available, plus a medium sized drying room (free of charge).

Wi-Fi access is free.

## Security

There are keys for all rooms.

## Shopping

We sell a limited stock of confectionary, snacks and toiletries. We also sell some alcoholic beverages.

There are shops, restaurants and bars nearby in the town centre.

## Directions

**Bus:** Citylink (Edinburgh/Glasgow-Inverness service). Alight at Fishers Hotel. Walk down the main street (Atholl Road). Turn first left up Bonneathill Road, first right (Toberargan Road) and first left (Well Brae). Go to the top of the hill and the hostel is on your left. Approximately a 5 minute walk.

**Train:** Edinburgh/Glasgow-Inverness service. Follow the road from the station up to the main street (Atholl Road). Turn right and walk down Atholl Road. Take the second left and walk up Bonneathill Road, then first right (Toberargan Road) and first left (Well Brae). Go to the top of the hill and the hostel is on your left. Approximately a 10-15 minute walk
