Rooms

Capacity 94:

- 12 twins
- 1 double
- 14 four-bedded
- 2 six-bedded

All rooms are en-suite (with extra toilet facilities around the building).

Family rates/private rooms available.

Room configurations may be subject to occasional change.

Catering

Continental and cooked breakfasts and packed lunches are available.

For groups of 10 and over we offer the choice of 1, 2 or 3 course dinner menus.

All food is freshly prepared on the premises.

Breakfast is normally served from 07.00-09.30. Dinner is served at an agreed time between 17.00-20.00. Arrangements can be made for alternative times on request.

Groups should reserve meals at the time of booking or at least 2 weeks prior to arrival.

The dining room can accommodate 50 people.

Self-catering

The kitchen is available 24 hours for checked-in guests with space for 12 people.

There are 3 hobs with 12 cooking rings, 3 domestic ovens, 2 fridges (no freezer) and 1 microwave.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's crockery and cutlery to suit staggered meal times for all guests.

Facilities

A lounge, with TV, can seat 30 people.

There are 2 token-operated washing machines and 2 dryers available from 07.00-23.00.

Towel hire is available.

A conference room, which can accommodate up to 30 people, is available for hire. Please ask the reservations team or youth hostel staff for details.

Wi-Fi access is free.

Security

There are swipe card operated locks on the rooms and downstairs corridors.

There are lockers in each room - bring your own padlock.

Storage for left luggage is not available.

Shopping

The hostel does not sell general food supplies, but drinks, snacks, confectionary and toiletries are available for purchase at reception.

We are also licensed to sell a range of local beers, cider and wine.

There are various supermarkets and cafes nearby.

Directions

Bus: from Stirling bus station walk into the town centre. Follow signs for Stirling Castle. The hostel is on St John Street, opposite the Tolbooth.

On foot: follow signs for Stirling Castle. The hostel is on St John Street, opposite the Tolbooth.

Car: follow signs for the town centre and then Stirling Castle. The hostel is on the left after the Highland Hotel.

Train: from Stirling train station walk into the town centre. Follow signs for Stirling Castle. The hostel is on St John Street, opposite the Tolbooth.

Parking

There are 8 car spaces in the car park. Parking can be reserved in advance by phoning or emailing the hostel directly. Should this be full, there is Pay & Display on-street parking. Meter times are from 08.45-06.30.

Coach access for drop off only. Drop off points at end of drive, or must reverse driveway. No turnaround available. There is no coach parking in the youth hostel grounds, so please arrange this prior to arrival (Stirling Castle offers coach parking).

There is secure cycle storage for up to 10 bikes at the side of the main building.

Local activities

Golf, fishing, hill walking, dry ski slope, football, pool, gym, sailing, cycle paths and bird watching.

Non-sporting attractions include pubs, clubs, restaurants and historic interests.

Stirling is close enough to Edinburgh for the Edinburgh Festival and Glasgow too.

Accessibility

Disabled access is all on the ground floor. The disabled access room has 2 beds and en-suite facilities, including a wet room. There is no disabled access to upper floors, TV room or laundry facilities.
