Capacity 65:

- 5 four-bedded
- 1 five-bedded
- 1 six-bedded (ensuite)

Room configurations may be subject
to occasional change. Two rooms are
currently en-suite.

Catering

Wee breakfasts and packed lunches are
available for individuals and groups.
Breakfast is normally served from
07.30-09.00 and the dining room can
seat 65 people.

All catering should be reserved at the
time of booking or at least 4 weeks prior
to arrival.

Self-catering

There are 7 hobs with 28 cooking rings
(gas and electric), 3 domestic ovens,
3 fridges and 1 microwave.

There is a selection of pots to cater for
individuals and groups and crockery and
cutlery available to suit staggered meal
times for all guests.

The kitchen is open between 07.00-
14.00 and 15.00-23.00. Closed nightly
23.00-07.00.

The dining room can seat 30 people.

Facilities

There are 2 lounge areas - one which
can accommodate up to 25 people, the
other up to 15 people.

Free tea and coffee is available on
request from reception, with chocolate
and soft drinks are available for guests
to buy.

There are 2 coin-operated washing and
drying machines and guests may use the
laundry after 19.00.

Wi-Fi access is free.

Security

All rooms have swipe cards and
individual cards are issued.

There is an additional security door with
swipe card access from reception to
main youth hostel areas.

Shopping

There's a small supermarket round
the corner from the youth hostel
(5 minutes' walk) and numerous
supermarkets in Union Street (15
minutes' walk).

There's a restaurant across the road
and a large choice of restaurants within
the city.

Directions

Bus: from the bus station, take X17 to
Queens Road. From Union Street take
the number 11 bus to Queens Road.

Airport: take 727 bus to city centre
bus station then X17.

Car: N or S, turn off Anderson Drive
(A90) at roundabout and follow signs
for B9119 City Centre.

Parking

Parking at the rear of the building is
available for up to 16 cars (drop off
point at the front of the hostel).

There's cycle storage for up to 12 bikes.

Coach parking is at some distance
from the hostel.
