



Welcome to Glasgow Youth Hostel

Situated in the popular West End of Scotland's largest city, overlooking Kelvingrove Park and Glasgow University, Glasgow Youth Hostel is the perfect base for groups, families and individuals looking to explore the city.

Reception

- Open 24 hours
- Check-in from 15.00
- Checkout by 10.00

You're welcome to arrive at any time and to use the youth hostel facilities if you arrive early or are departing late. Left luggage can be arranged, subject to availability.

Dogs are now welcome, for a small fee, when you book a private room. Please let us know in advance, to ensure that a dog friendly room is allocated.

Rooms

Capacity 108:

- 4 singles
- 12 double/twin-bedded
- 5 four-bedded
- 7 six-bedded
- 1 eight-bedded

All rooms are en-suite (room configurations may be subject to occasional change).

The hostel has an additional 6 spaces in its self-contained flat which comprises:

- 1 twin-bedded room
- 1 four-bedded room (2 bunks)
- lounge
- bathroom
- kitchen
- dining area

The flat has spectacular views of Glasgow's south side and is ideal for families or small groups. Please contact the hostel directly to book

Catering

Glasgow Youth Hostel offers its guests a full range of catering options including cooked and continental breakfasts (served 07.30-09.00) and packed lunches.

1, 2 and 3 course evening meals are available for groups over 20 (please book these 4 weeks in advance). Our dining room can seat 60 comfortably.

Self-catering

The kitchen has space for 10 people.

There are 5 hobs with 20 cooking rings (gas), 1 domestic oven, 2 fridges and 1 microwave.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery to suit meal times for all guests.

The dining room seats 30 people.

Facilities

There's a large, comfortable lounge and a TV room which seats 35 people, as well as a games room with pool table and jukebox.

3 token-operated washing and drying machines are available all day (tokens can be bought at reception). Our excellent drying room is free.

A meeting/conference room is available to hire.

Wi-Fi access is free.

Security

There's a security door from reception, CCTV throughout the building and swipe card entry to all the bedrooms, helping to create a secure environment for guests.

There are lockable lockers in all rooms and padlocks are available to buy from reception.

A luggage room is available to guests at no extra charge.

Shopping

There are various supermarkets nearby for grocery shopping.

You can buy snacks, drinks, souvenirs and travel essentials from reception. Tour booking is also available.

Directions

Train: take the number 4/4a bus from Hope Street (near Central Station) to the first stop on Woodlands Road. Follow the youth hostel signs from here.

Car: if driving **west** on the M8, exit at Junction 18 (signposted Charing Cross & Kelvingrove) and follow signs for the youth hostel.

If driving **east** on M8, exit at Junction 17 (signposted Dumbarton), branch left for Aberfoyle and turn left at the traffic lights. Follow the brown signs to the youth hostel from there.

Taxis from the bus or train stations cost around £7.

Parking

On-street parking is charged between Monday-Friday 08.00-18.00 with a 3 hour maximum stay.
