Welcome to Oban & Oban Lodge Youth Hostel

Reception

- Open 07.00-23.00
- Check-in from 15.00
- Checkout by 10.00

Late arrival and access outside opening hours is by pre-arrangement only.

Guests in private rooms do not have to vacate during the day as long as they allow cleaners in to empty bins, etc.

Guests arriving by public transport before check-in time of 15.00 are welcome to drop off luggage, which is stored free of charge in a locked luggage room.

Dogs are welcome, for a small fee, when booking a private room. Please notify us in advance to ensure that a dog friendly room is available.

Rooms

Capacity 75 in 2 buildings.

Main building (55 rooms)

- 3 four-bedded (2 with single-over-double & 1 with bunks)
- 6 six-bedded (2 private)
- 1 seven-bedded

All rooms are en-suite. There are also 2 public bathrooms on the first floor. Room configurations may be subject to occasional change.

Oban Lodge (20 rooms)

- 4 double-bedded
- 6 twin-bedded

All rooms are en-suite and are perfect for families or private room hire.

RentaHostel

The Lodge is available to hire for sole use at a very competitive price.

Catering

Continental breakfasts, cooked breakfasts and packed lunches are available throughout the year.

Evening meals are available for groups of 10 or more - by prior arrangement only with the hostel at time of booking.

Breakfast is served between 07.30-09.00, but may be available earlier by prior arrangement with the hostel.

Breakfast and packed lunches should be booked during check-in or by 23.00 the previous evening at the latest.

We recommend that groups of 10 or more book meals at least 4 weeks before arrival.

Self-catering

Both the main building and the lodge have kitchens available for guests and are equipped with everything you could need to create a simple snack or a gourmet meal - pots, pans, glasses, cookers, hobs, microwave, freezer (main building only), kettles and water boiler, sinks, drying cloths, washing-up liquid, recycling bins, teapots, water jugs, cooking utensils, casseroles, etc.

Crockery and cutlery are provided and all we ask is that you wash dishes and tidy up after use.

The kitchens are open from 07.00-10.30 and from 13.00-23.00.

Facilities

In the main building, the lounge can seat about 20 people. It has a small library, board games, toy box and TV. The dining room can seat around 50 and the self-catering kitchen about 30.

The kitchen/lounge in the lodge can seat about 20 people and also has a TV.

A laundry room is available. It has a token operated washer/dryer (tokens can be purchased at reception).

The laundry is closed to guests between 07.00-15.00, but a drying room is freely accessible.

Wi-Fi access is free.

Security

All rooms have lockers. You can bring your own padlock or buy one at reception if necessary.

A locked cycle shed can hold up to 20 bikes.

Shopping

There's a small shop at reception where you can buy confectionary, soft drinks and other sundry items.

A selection of wines, bottled beers and ciders is also available.

There are three supermarkets on the outskirts of town as well as shops in the town centre.

Directions

Bus/train/ferry: the bus, train and ferry terminals are about a 10 minute walk away. Keeping the sea on your left, walk around the bay and Oban Youth Hostel is on the seafront on your right.

Car: as you descend the hill into the town, continue through the first roundabout and at the second one turn right. Continue for about 0.25 mile and the hostel is on your right.

Parking

The car park, which is free, can hold about 14 cars and is on a first come first served basis.

If coaches inform the youth hostel 48 hours prior to arrival, we will try to reserve a space (not guaranteed).

Alternative parking (chargeable) is a 5 minute walk from the youth hostel.

Local activities

Oban Youth Hostel can supply lots of information on things to see and do and family activities - such as the Highland Glass Workshops - as well as timetables for trains/buses/ferries. The local Tourist Information Centre is a 10 minute walk away.

Activities include water sports, forest walks, climbing and wildlife. There are various local festivals including Highlands and Islands Music Festival, Seafood Festival, Winter Festival and The Royal Highland Games. Oban is also an important venue for shinty competitions. Several venues have traditional music throughout the summer season

Accessibility

There are ramps to the main and lodge buildings (but not to the laundry and drying room). One of the ground floor double/twin rooms in the lodge has disabled access facilities. There's a disabled toilet in the main building reception.
